### Directions to Suffolk

#### Closest MBTA stops:

- On the **Blue Line**: Government Center
- On the **Green Line**: Park Street
- On the **Orange Line**: State Street
- On the **Red Line**: Park Street

#### Driving:

(Please note that directions are based on most recent information based on the opening of the 93N tunnel and 93S). You can check the Big Dig Website at <http://www.bigdig.com/thtml/traffic.htm> or the Massachusetts Turnpike website at <http://www.masspike.com/> for more information.)

#### • From the North:

Take Expressway 93S or Rte.1 South (the two merge in Boston) across the Leonard Zakim-Bunker Hill Bridge into the new 93S tunnel. Take Exit No. 24A Government Center / Faneuil Hall; at the end of the ramp follow signs for Government Center/Faneuil Hall; at the set of traffic lights make a left onto North Street. At the end of North Street (1/4th of a mile) make a right onto Congress Street; go approximately 3 blocks to New Chardon Street; turn left onto New Chardon Street; the entrance to the Government Center Garage is on your left. From here you should be able to walk to any Suffolk University building.

#### • From the South:

Take Interstate 95N to Interstate 93N to Boston; enter the new 93N tunnel; there are only two exits off the new tunnel, take exit 23 (Government Center); at the bottom of the ramp bear right onto New Chardon Street; the entrance to the Government Center Garage is on your left; OR continue to the second set of lights; take a left onto Cambridge Street; and look for the Center Plaza Parking Garage entrance on your right. From here you should be able to walk to any Suffolk University building.

#### • From the West:

Take Massachusetts Turnpike 90 East to Expressway 93N; enter the new I-93N tunnel; there are only two exits off the new tunnel, take exit 23 (Government Center); at the bottom of the ramp bear right onto New Chardon Street; the entrance to the Government Center Garage is on your left; OR continue to the second set of lights; take a left onto Cambridge Street; and look for the Center Plaza Parking Garage entrance on your right. From here you should be able to walk to any Suffolk University building.

#### • From Logan Airport:

Exit the airport and follow the signs to Boston/Sumner Tunnel; there is a \$3.00 toll when traveling from the tunnel into Boston; upon exiting the tunnel bear right; immediately after the first traffic light, take the second left and then a sharp left onto Blackstone Street; at the end of Blackstone Street turn right onto North Street; proceed to the first traffic light, intersection of North Street and Congress Street; turn right onto Congress Street; follow the signs to the Government Center Garage on New Chardon Street (Safe Harbor Parking) approximately 3 blocks ahead on your left. From here you should be able to walk to any Suffolk University building.
